Hello family,

All is going really great in H&I! We're very excited about not only the service opportunities ahead of us but with the renewed participation in our area as well. For the last few months there have been an average of 4 new people per month being oriented to do H&I meetings in our area. Our current meetings are going well and we've been in contact with Valley in person to discuss the re formation of the meeting there. I will be submitting the names and contact information of the people this week that want to attend the orientation at Valley for the facility. We just need around 6 for this that will rotate the panel leader position over the next few terms. We can also bring in people with the facility oriented people providing they've done our H&I orientation and have filled out a HEPPA form and waiver before entering each facility visit. The agreed upon time and day for this meeting to take place will be on Wednesdays at 6:30 pm. The time and date for the orientation has not yet been set. I'm hoping to have that set and scheduled by the end of the week.

WE have rotated two panel leader positions with Joanna R now being the panel leader for Sholze and Lisa S being the new panel leader for CADAS detox. Sarah S has fully stepped into her roll as secretary and Lisa M has become our new literature person for H&I. We've also been contacted by Walker State prison about the possibility of volunteers being allowed back in in July. I have sent all the badge renewal information to all the current participants and will contact the volunteer director this week about the upcoming certification class schedule for any new volunteers. As soon as I know something about that I will make announcements accordingly for people that want to get involved.

We also still have had some questions and expressions of willingness from some in our area about Bradly county jail and an opportunity to serve there, There are people there that are willing to get involved. More will be revealed as we discuss this and other potential service opportunities in our area. I ask GSR'S and panel leaders and other trusted servants to please announce these service opportunities in your homegroups as we move forward in carrying our message to the addict who still suffers.
